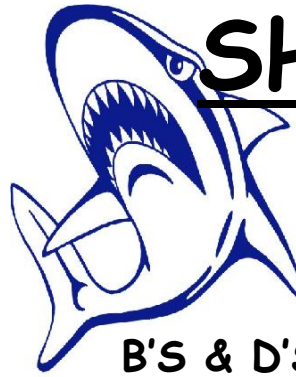
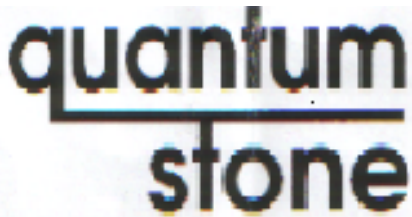

For the second consecutive year, the Henley Sharks chances of bringing home a premiership have been left to the B and D grade sides.

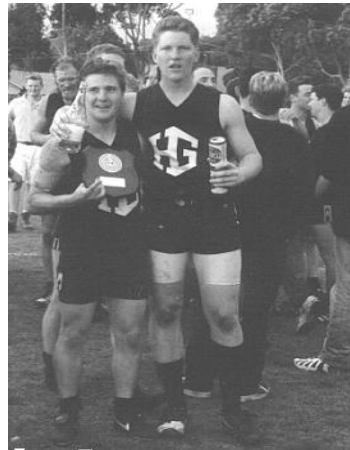
