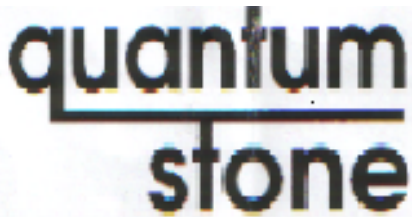

Radio Madagascar reported Friday that Stade Olympique l'Emyrne scored the own goals against Adema as a protest after SOE's coach lost his temper with the referee.

Spectators told the radio that SOE repeatedly kicked the ball into their own net after each kickoff and scored 149 own goals.

Adema's players reportedly stood around looking bemused, doing nothing to stop the opposition from self-destructing.

The result became a new world-record score for a match in first-class soccer.

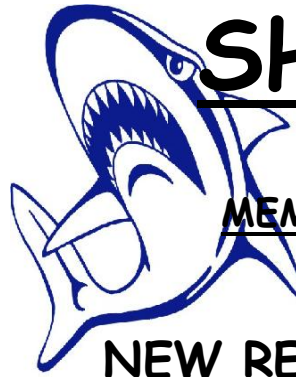
