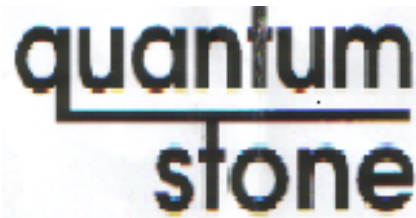

## SHARK'S CLEAN SWEEP!

What a week for the Henley Sharks with 4 wins in 4 grades by an average of nearly 98 points....INCREDIBLE!

It started with the A grade demolishing cellar-dwellers Walkerville, 17.18 (120) to 5.3 (33) at home on Saturday. Darren Chandler, in perhaps his last game for the club, played brilliantly booting 6 goals (5 before 1/2 time). Lambo, Lettsy and 'Disco' Dumesny, were also vital players in a confidence boosting game. The boys must now face a tougher challenge, in Rostrevor, next week as both teams vie for a finals spot.

The B's got back on the winners list and gave coach 'Patty' a big smile with a convincing 13.19 (97) to 5.2 (32) win in difficult conditions. Brommers and 'Hooker' Loveder both booted 3 for the Sharks while Piero, Tonka, 'Ozzie' Martin and 'Chopper' Read were the best performers. The next few weeks are must wins if the B's want to cement a spot in the top 5 come the major round.

Lowie's C grade team put in a mighty effort to knock of the lowly Woody South Cats by a whopping 119 points on a muddy Ledger Reserve. Roenfeldt, Tonkin and former full back 'DJ' Jolly all kicked 4 goals while big Steve Mugge, the skipper Atticus Boyce and Kym Nienaber were best, in a good team performance. Final scores: Henley 22.10 (142) def. Woodville South 3.5 (23). The boys will be looking for a big win again this week against Athelstone to cement a top 5 spot and push for the top 3.

Jimmy and the D grade capped off the clean sweep with a big 95 point win in the mud and rain. The veteran Schwarz dominated proceedings with a lazy 5 goal performance up forward while 'Wooly' Woolend also played well, booting two. Final scores: Henley 19.17 (131) def. Woodville South 5.6 (36). Jimmy would be pretty happy with his lads at the moment, sitting 2<sup>nd</sup> and looking to get another solid win this week.
