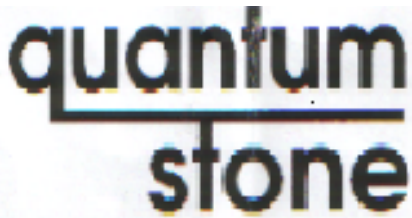
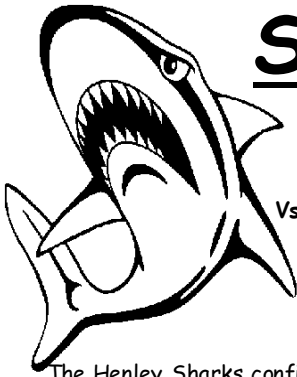

## SHARKS SKIN WOLVES

The Henley Sharks confirmed their place as a genuine finals contender with a fiery 3-point win over the second placed Tea Tree Gully on the weekend. The moral-boosting win lifted the Henley side to within 2 games of 3<sup>rd</sup> position on the ladder and dropped the Wolves to 5<sup>th</sup> position in an extremely tight competition. The Sharks built a 4 goal lead going into the last quarter, but an all-in brawl resulted in the Wolves refocussing and quickly booting 3 to get back into the game. However some tight defence saw the Henley side prevail, winning 8.5 (53) to 7.8 (50). Brown, Leeves, Lettsy and Schultz were best for the Sharks with Quinny kicking 4 goals. The boys need to keep focussed and keep winning if they want to confirm a finals spot and have a good chance to boost percentage against a lowly placed Athelstone this week.

Patty Carpenter was celebrating with all the vigour of a premiership coach after a fantastic 1 point win over the division leaders on the weekend. Many tequila slammers were consumed by the B graders after getting up 7.6 (48) to 6.11 (47). The match went goal-for-goal all day, but by late in the last quarter, the Wolves had managed to build an 11 point buffer. For perhaps the first time this year, the boys really dug in hard and a goal to young Tim Jones with 2 minutes to go was the match-winner. Ricky Hutchins, 'Chef' Kite and under 17's player Thomas Wright were the best for the Sharks, with Wright booting 3 and Smithy 2. This week should see a good win to the B's to get them right back in the hunt for the finals.

The C grade struggled against an improved TTG and lost the game in the 1<sup>st</sup> half with atrocious checking and the continued desire to play dry-weather footy. The second half saw a change in attitude and endeavour from the boys who produced a great 2<sup>nd</sup> half, proving what a great football side they can be when they are on the ball. However, the damage had already been done and the final siren saw the Sharks going down 16.16 (112) to 7.1 (43). Special mentions must go to Tony Rutter and Andy Bray, both booting 2 goals after playing in the D grade earlier. Also good player were the skipper, Atticus Boyce, Thommo at full back and big Mick Lockett in the ruck. The boys will be looking for revenge against Gaza this week after being embarrassed by them earlier in the year.

The D grade lost only their third game for the season, albeit with only 17 players for the whole game. The players who bothered to rock up battled gallantly but found the going tough with one man short and ended up going down 8.17 (65) to 4.8 (32). Best for the D's were Bray, Murphy and Dazzling Darrel Aldridge, while Dobner kicked 2 majors. The D's will need a full team and a good win this week to keep their break on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> sides.
