CLUB INFORMATION

We are a part of the SAUCNA competition (www.saucna.net) who have teams in the following age groups:

Under 8s, 9, 11s, 13s, 15s, 17s and Opens.

WHERE WILL WE PLAY AND TRAIN?

Our home courts will be located on Cudmore Terrace, Henley Beach, opposite the Henley High School. All teams will train here, and the Juniors will play their home games at this location.

Juniors away games are played at various locations across Metropolitan Adelaide.

Under 17s and Opens play at the Association courts at the corner of Anzac Highway and Greenhill Road in the City.

The Seasons usually begin in late March with the Grand Final being held mid-August.

For Juniors training will begin mid-March, once a week on a Tuesday or Thursday afternoon, with exact times to be determined. Opens and Under 17s can be discussed. We aim to have all players and the coach agree on a time but ask for understanding and flexibility.

Games are played on Saturday afternoons at either 12.30pm, 2.00pm or 3.30pm. The younger grades usually play earlier but this will be confirmed when the program is released.

TEAM PLACEMENT

Dependent on the numbers of players in each grade:

Under 8s and 9s will not trial in positions but be placed on ability and with consideration of friendships – we will aim to place you with a minimum of 1 nominated friend (not guaranteed). Up to 3 friends can be nominated.

Under 11s, 13s and 15s will trial in positions and be placed on ability. This process ensures the development of teams and individuals.

Under 17s and Opens will be made up at the discretion of the Netball Committee Officers. Depending on numbers trials may need to occur.

HOW MUCH ARE THE FEES?

Our registration fees will be \$200. Uniforms will also need to be purchased at a later stage.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

Umpiring

Without umpires we cannot operate or field teams.

Opens and Under 17s – we must submit the same number of umpires as teams. We will not be allowed to take court until we do. We will be asking for assistance in sourcing umpires.

Under 8s to Under 15s – we require a pool of umpires to be allocated to home games. We will be asking your assistance in umpiring these games or help with actively recruiting umpires. Training courses will be offered along with umpire support.

Coaches

Each team requires a coach. Focus of coaches will be development of players skills with safety and welfare as a priority. Coaches are responsible for ensuring all players play equal court time throughout the season and ensuring all players have the opportunity to learn multiple positions.
