PRE SEASON REPORT - JARRAD PARKER A Grade Senior Coach 2019

Round 1 2019 is here already, in some ways it's a long time coming in others, time has flown. We have had some off field changes with Chris Brown taking a step back after working harder than most over the last 3 years. But with change comes some fresh ideas; Brian Leys has taken up the Football Director role, James Stewart comes in as an A Grade assistant to replace the departing Ryan Sampson, Rod Cavenett has returned for another stint in the coaches box with the C Grade and Kurtis Cox has taken the reigns with the U18's.

We've had a big turnover of players this year, but we are very confident in those that are now with us. After the majority of our older players decided to finish up at the end of last year, it became our focus to recruit and build a young group that will grow together towards our next premiership. We have maintained our core midfield, keys targets and emerging players and have deliberately targeted players that will not only compliment the group but fit into our club's values. As a result you can feel the genuine anticipation of what we are building amongst the senior group. Rather than the usual report on preseason training, I'd like to introduce some of our new players;

Ricky O'Loughlin – Is a key defender who has moved across from country Victoria. He uses his voice and experience well and has great skills for a key position player.

Lachlan Ryan – Joins us from West Adelaide and currently with the Crows top up list. He is a very composed wingman who rarely makes a wrong decision.

Sam Abell – Joins us from Glenunga where he was one of their captains. He can play multiple roles, but we hope to use his great reach and work rate down back.

Liam Martin – Has joined us from the Eagles where he comes highly recommended. He is a dashing wingman who can hit a leading forward when at full speed and finds plenty of it.

Charlie Morrison – Has joined us late after also moving across from country Victoria, he is another key defender who reads the ball very well in the air to take intercept marks in the back half.

Malachai Ahmatt-Lovett – Is a late addition to our squad, has spent some time at Centrals and is one of those blokes for whom the game seems to slow down around him. He will provide some great highlights this year.

Ryhan Fitzpatrick – Comes to us from SMOSH and is as honest at the ball as the day is long. He is one player you can guarantee will give you effort.

A big focus of our recruiting was also to get former players and juniors back to the club, those we see returning are;

Nathan Bowles – Great tap ruck man who left us 3 years ago due to work commitments but is now back and has developed his craft nicely.

Angus Coxon – Played with the Sharks in 2017 but spent last year at Port Adelaide, his work ethic and hunger for the football can't be questioned.

Harry Sibley – After spending a few years at the Eagles he is back with us, a pure user of the football you'll enjoy his run off of half back.

Lachie Barreau – Coming back to us from PHOS he is a talented utility who doesn't have trouble finding the football.

Adrian Corso – Off the back of a Glenelg U18 best and fairest and now training with the Eagles but is calling us home again this year.

Josh Hornibrook – A player with immense talent, can play forward or through the middle, after a late start to the year due to other commitments you will only see him get better the longer the year goes.

Jack Hambly – A genuine talent up forward who returns from Flinders Park after kicking almost 100 goals there in the B grade last year.

In addition, after winning a B Grade premiership last year and with potentially more opportunities this year, we are hoping some of our younger players like Jackson Smith, Cody Egel, Jack Calabro, Kyle Dalidowicz, Brodie Kitto, Kyle Nicol, Josh Pierson and Joel Friel take that next step in their development to become consistent A grade footballers.

This list isn't to forget the strong base of core players, and club favourites, who we are building our team around. One thing I can guarantee is you will see some exciting football played this year, with a young group that is hungry to improve and achieve success.
